"The object of the charity is, in the interests of social welfare, to improve the conditions of life of the inhabitants of the area of benefit without distinction of political or religious or other opinions by the provision and maintenance of :

- (A) a village hall for use by the inhabitants, including use for
 - (i) meetings, lectures and classes and
 - (ii) other forms of recreation and leisure time occupation; and
- (B) A recreation ground for use by the inhabitants."
